Highlights 2022 – 2023

As we move further out from the Covid-19 pandemic, the Billy Mock Foundation continues its operations and pursues its mission of 'simply helping others' in the following ways:

Educational Grants

In 2023, the Billy Mock Foundation's Educational Grants Committee awarded \$10,000 in needs-based, community service based, and institutional grants.

- \$4000 in needs-based grants were awarded to students from St. Laurence School in Upper Darby and St Thomas the Apostle School in Glen Mills.
- \$4500 in "Simply Helping Others" community service-based grants were awarded to students from St Agnes School in West Chester, St. Thomas the Apostle School in Glen Mills, St. Joseph School in Downingtown, Serviam Girls Academy in Wilmington, Holy Family School in Aston, and St. Maximillian Kolbe School in West Chester.
- A \$1500 Institutional Grant was awarded to Serviam Girls Academy in Wilmington DE in recognition of and in support of their work of cultivating the potential of middle school aged young women through a challenging, holistic curriculum, tuition-free, including an extended 10-hour school day and 10-month school year, reducing the students' exposure to the difficulties and temptations of inner-city life. These awards were made possible by you our donors and supporters enabling our Educational Grants committee to continue our Foundation's mission of Simply Helping Others.

Pay it Forward

-The largest grant ever provided by the foundation was awarded to the ACCESS Chester Community Center in Chester, PA. Our grant was then matched by a generous benefactor for a total of \$25,000.
