Billy Mock was a loving Christian with a dynamic enthusiasm for life. His infectiously positive attitude, ever-present smile and vibrant personality literally impacted the lives of thousands of people. Billy began fighting brain cancer in 2005 and touched thousands of lives until his death in 2007 at the age of 13.

The Billy Mock Foundation is a tribute to Billy and his compassion for people, love for life, and passion for sports.

Our mission is simply to "help others" which is achieved through the "Pay it Forward" program which is to encourage people to help others; educational grants; and support of families in need - especially those with a sick child.

The Billy Mock Foundation (a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization) was established in 2008, on what would have been Billy's 14th birthday, by the Mock Family and friends. It has awarded numerous scholarships, provided financial support to many families in the region, and supported many local groups working within our community to improve the lives of others.

The Billy Mock Foundation recognized and supported front line workers at both Riddle and Chester County Hospitals during the Covid crisis.

Families in Need Program

Throughout 2022 - 2023, we assisted eight families experiencing loss of employment, critical illness and life crisis. We provided payments for living expenses, energy bills, car payments, food expenses and medical bills.

During the Thanksgiving holiday season, we arranged for turkeys and Acme gift cards for participants of the Goodwill of Delaware and Delaware County work program. The Christmas season found us adopting three local families struggling with expenses during the holiday season and provided Christmas gifts for the entire family and Acme gift cards to assist with their holiday meal preparations, families in need through the St. Thomas Caring and Sharing Giving Tree outreach project and providing Christmas presents and clothing for the children.

Educational Grants Program

In 2022-23, the Billy Mock Foundation Educational Grant Committee awarded \$9000 in Six (6) needs-based grants and one "Simply Helping Others†community service-based grant were awarded to students from the following schools:

- Blessed Virgin Mary School in Darby, PA
- Saint Agnes School in West Chester, PA
 St Thomas the Apostle School in Glen Mills, PA

An institutional grant to Drexel Neumann Academy in Chester was provided.

The Educational Grant Committee funded two (2) Saint Thomas the Apostle Alumni Grants in Billy's memory.

Pay It Forward Program

The Billy Mock Foundation made a \$25,000 donation to the newly opened ACCESS Community Center in Chester, PA. (www.accesschester.org). This is the largest single donation made by the Foundation in its history. This donation was made possible by the consistent generosity of our donors and sponsors and by a generous directed donation of \$10,000 from Phylis Ann Mariani (PAM), Billy's cousin. The donation by Pam is also the largest donation to the Foundation from an individual/family. It doubles the previous record set 2 years ago by Michael & B.J. Connor, who are also Billy's cousins.

The ACCESS Community Center (located at 701 Booth St. Chester, PA) will provide resources and support to the community of Chester as its residents struggle with the challenges of food insecurity, insufficient housing, poverty, mental illness, and addictions. And most importantly, they will provide companions on the journey for those in need. ACCESS will be offering a daily meal and a food pantry, and has space for classes, gatherings, and resources. The facility is handicap accessible which will allow for all to gather there. Laundry and shower facilities are also available for those who do not have access to those basic services.

The Billy Mock Foundation became aware of the ACCESS Community Center through its long relationship with Sr. Cathy McGowan, SSJ and Sr. Maggie Gannon, OSF. Over the 12 years of working with the good Sisters, the Foundation was able to identify and assist many individuals and programs who are truly in need in the city of Chester. Sr. Maggie commented that "We continue to marvel at the impact Billy's life has on so many." It brings tears to our eyes and pride to our hearts, and gratitude to all of you who support us in our mission of "Simply Helping Others"


