Highlights 2023 – 2024

As we move further out from the Covid-19 pandemic, the Billy Mock Foundation continues its operations and pursues its mission of 'simply helping others' in the following ways:

Educational Grants

For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, The Billy Mock Foundation's Educational Grants Committee awarded a total of \$14,000 in educational grants to students and schools in the greater Philadelphia area.

-For the past 16 years, The Billy Mock Foundation has been awarding educational grants to 8th grade students to financially assist their transition to high school. This year we awarded 8th grade Needs-Based and Community-Service Based (Simply Helping Others) Educational Grants totaling \$8500 to students in the following schools: St Thomas the Apostle School in Glen Mills, St. Laurence School in Darby, Mother of Providence School in Wallingford, Serviam Academy in Wilmington DE, St. Joseph's School in Downingtown, and Holy Family School in Aston.

-Additionally, a \$1500 Institutional Educational Grant was awarded to Serviam Academy in Wilmington DE for their commitment to helping others by providing a tuition-free, quality, faith-based education to low-income girls in order to prepare them for admittance into competitive high schools and ultimately, to college.

-Also this year, we introduced for the first time The Billy Mock Foundation's Stephen Sheller and Billy Mock Memorial Tuition Assistance Grants at St. Thomas the Apostle School in Glen Mills where Billy and Stephen attended. These grants were made possible by a generous donation from the Bernert/Hartman Family as well as the many memorial donations made in Stephen's honor, directed by The Sheller Family to the Billy Mock Foundation. This year \$4,000 in tuition assistance grants was provided. These Stephen Sheller and Billy Mock Memorial Tuition Assistance Grants were awarded to students in grades Pre-K through 7th grade who demonstrate the qualities of kindness, helpfulness, and a commitment to St. Thomas the Apostle School. The awards are directly applied to their tuition at STA.

Pay it Forward

Since the inception of the Billy Mock Foundation, the Pay It Forward Program has contributed funds into the community to continue its mission of "**simply helping others**". The program was originated to award grants to nonprofit groups or organizations who directly use the awarded funds to help within the community. This year the Pay it Forward program donated \$12,000 directly into the community. Some of the organizations included The ACCESS Chester Community Center for their food pantry, The Mark Dombroski Foundation, The Victoria Rose Fund, The Judi Marvel Charities, and The Damascus Missionary to help fund youth group camps.

-We provided funds to the Ridley High School girls basketball team enabling them to adopt a needy family over the holidays.

-We provided funds to the Goodwill annual Christmas fund.

-We provided financial assistance to programs that help local families in need.

-We donated to Manbroso's (a local business) to help them rebuild following a devastating fire.

Families in Need

---3 local families struggling financially during the holiday season were provided with Christmas gifts for the entire family (7 children total), including Acme gift cards to assist with their holiday meal preparations.
